ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be a high school senior residing in the Lucia Mar Unified School District area.
2. Must be planning to continue your education in the field of performing arts.
3. Must have a minimum of 2.0 grade point average and meet all graduation requirements.
4. Must attach a Student Data Printout with picture, Transcript of Student Progress, and a video clip, as follows: 1-2 minutes long; identify yourself at the beginning; may be delivered on a CD, DVD, or flash drive. Videos should be filmed horizontally to be viewed on a television screen. Please also submit your senior photo or recent headshot*.
5. For final selection, audition required. The scholarship amount will be determined at time of audition.
